Leaving from New York, you will enjoy a day at sea aboard the Norwegian Crown. Spend that day soaking up the sun by the pool, trying your luck in the casino or maybe learning a new dance step. Want some pampering? Head up to the spa and get a massage or facial. There's a kid's center and a jogging track. Plus, there are 6 restaurants and 7 bars and lounges. Aboard the Crown, it's all about you. This is "freestyle cruising"- eat when you want, no need to dress up, sleep when you want, do whatever YOU want to do.

On the second day, head to the front of the ship as we enter a narrow inlet that brings us to St. Georges – the first capitol of Bermuda. Once docked, you have all day and night to explore the history of the area, you can explore the area by foot or take an organized tour. This is a chance to see what Bermuda was like in the 1700's.

As the sun comes up on day 3, get up early and watch as we sail away from St. Georges. Spend the morning enjoying breakfast on deck as we sail along the coast of Bermuda. If you haven't already, now is a good time to start planning the rest of the week as we sail into Hamilton – capital and financial center of Bermuda. As we dock on Front Street, the Crown becomes your hotel. Step off the ship right onto the street.

For the next 2 ½ days, you can come and go at your leisure. Don't worry about dinner, it'll be waiting for you when you return. You can shop at Hamilton's duty free shops, head to the beach, take a shore excursion or just relax. Like to golf? Bermuda has some of the best courses in the world – and we can get you tee times! Maybe you would rather fish – get ready to try your hand at deep sea and reef fishing. How will you get around? The Bermudian transportation system is very convenient. For the brave, you can rent a moped and explore the island on your own. Think your evenings will be boring? Not a chance. On the Crown, the lounges are opened and there's a different show every night. You can also hit the town and enjoy the Bermudian restaurants and nightlife and don't worry - the ship will be there when you want to come back.

On day 5, after some last minute shopping, come up on deck and wave good-bye to Bermuda as the Crown pulls away from Hamilton and heads back home. But the fun hasn't stopped. For the next day and a half, the ship comes alive with shows, craft demonstrations, dancing, shopping and eating –more!

As Sunday morning arrives, enjoy an early breakfast and watch New York City awake as we sail up the Hudson to the pier. As you depart the ship, say good-bye to your new friends and start thinking about your next cruise!
